MODE OF TEST

Candidate can choose any one of the two options to take the test:

Paper- Pencil Test (Offline Test)

or

Computer Based Test (Online Test)

PAPER PENCIL TEST

Test Date: **5th September 2010**, from 10.00 am to 12:30 pm (reporting time: 9:00 am).

COMPUTER BASED TEST

Test Date: **11th September 2010 onwards**

Test Timings: In Different Time Slots subject to number of candidates registering for Computer Based Test.

ELIGIBILITY

Graduate in any discipline from a recognized university. Final year degree course students can also apply.

HOW TO APPLY

There are three ways to apply:

- Obtain Form with MAT Bulletin/CD against cash payment of **Rs 1200/- (One thousand two hundred only)** from listed branches of Bank of Baroda, listed Study Centres of AIMA OR against cash payment of **Rs 1050/- (One thousand fifty only)** from AIMA, New Delhi.
- Obtain crossed DD of Rs. 1050/- in favour of 'All India Management Association' payable at Delhi from any Bank. Register online at website link **www.aima-ind.org**

ADMIT CARD

All provisionally registered candidates can download their Admit Card from AIMA website link: www.aima-ind.org/matcentre.asp 7 days before the test date **i.e. with effect from 28 August 2010 (Saturday)**.

TEST CENTERS

Test Centre City list is provided in the bulletin. Test Venues for Paper-Pencil Test and Computer Based Test (Online) are different.

The Paper-Pencil Test will take place only on one day i.e., 5th September 2010 at one time slot i.e., 10.00am-12.30pm, whereas the Computer Based Test (Online Test) will take place from 11th September 2010 onwards in different time slots. If the number of candidates registered for Computer Based Test (Online Test) is few/limited, these candidates have to appear for the paper-Pencil Test on 5th September 2010 only. One candidate can appear only for one date for the September 2010 MAT.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Specific Admit Card will be generated both for the candidates opted for the Paper Based Test and for the Computer Based Test.

Admit Card would be having Candidate Name, Form No, Roll NO, Test Date, Test Time and Test Venue Address. Candidate has to strictly follow the date and time allotted to them in the case of Computer Based Test.

Candidates who applied for Computer Based Test and who have been permitted to appear for the Computer Based Test have to download the Admit Card 7 days before the Paper Based Test date i.e., with effect from 28 August 2010 (Saturday) from AIMA website. Candidates accessing the website the earliest can choose the Date and Time of his/her choice subject to availability. Those who have not opted for the date and time slot for 4-5 days will be automatically allotted date and time slot by the system. No request for change of date and time slot can be entertained.
